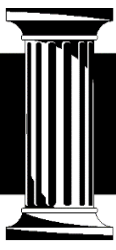

Construction Update

We recently completed the installation of pedestrian gates and fencing at the Education Center. Vehicle gates have been installed at three of the four entrances. Trenching and back-fill has been completed for electrical to operate the vehicle gates.

Next, we will install low voltage and high voltage wiring to operate gates, lighting, and for video surveillance. We anticipate the vehicle gates to be operational by the end of July. 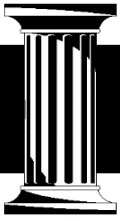

Their objections come from insecurity; their lack of faith in Jesus is a lack of faith in themselves and finally a lack of faith at what God can do in and through any person. 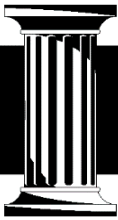

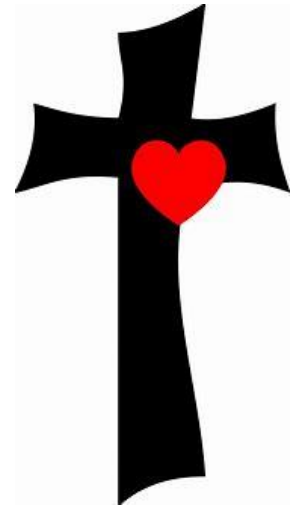
