

# Stewardship...

**Feast of the Presentation of the Lord**<u>Mal 3:1-4; PS 24:7-10; HEB 2:14-18; LK 2:22-40 or LK 2:22-32</u>



Today we celebrate the Feast of the Presentation of the Lord, when Mary and Joseph brought their infant Son to the Temple in obedience to the laws of their Jewish faith. This is a beautiful, and in many ways, mysterious feast – one that is filled with lessons for a stewardship way of life.

Our first reading, from the book of Malachi, includes a prophecy of the event we celebrate today. "Lo, I am sending my messenger [a reference to John the Baptist] to prepare the way before me; and suddenly there will come to the temple the Lord whom you seek...." Our first lesson is contained in the words, "the Lord whom you seek." Do we truly seek the Lord through prioritizing our relationship with Him above everything (and everyone) else in our lives? If we want to know Him and His will for our lives, we must spend time with Him in prayer, reception of the sacraments, and the study of our faith. Only then will we be ready when he "suddenly appears" in our lives. As "stewards" we are ready when we spend Time with God as our first priority.

Our Gospel passage from Luke, recounting the details of the Presentation, teaches us a stewardship lesson through the example of St. Joseph and the Blessed Mother, the "Holy Parents." They carefully observed the faith practices of their day by bringing him to the temple "to present Him to the Lord just as it is written in the law of the Lord." Later in the passage we read that, "When they had fulfilled all the prescriptions of the law of the Lord, they returned to their own town of Nazareth." Jesus' parents were good stewards of their child, teaching Him to live in obedience to the practices of their faith from his infancy and throughout His "growing up" years. They said "Yes" to God's requests to be faithful stewards.

Those of us entrusted with the care of children, whether our own children, godchildren, nieces, and nephews, grandchildren, or students, have a vital role to play in the faith formation of these young ones. We, like Mary and Joseph, must steward these children well, forming them in our faith by instruction and example throughout their lives.

What a privilege we have as Christian stewards. May we take these stewardship lessons to heart and present our gifts and our young ones joyfully to the Lord.

### Something to think about:

Like Malachi, do we truly seek the Lord by prioritizing our relationship with Him above everything else? Just like a close friend or spouse, if we want to really know God, we must spend time with Him to grow in our faith so that we understand what He wants and expects from us. In his Gospel, Luke by recounting the details of the Presentation of Jesus in the Temple, teaches us as parents and grandparents a stewardship lesson by the example of St. Joseph and the Blessed Mother.

As Jesus' parents, they observed the faith practices of their day. As parents, we are called to follow their example and bring our children to Mass, to the sacraments, and to Family Faith Formation classes so that their faith is formed. As stewards, we teach our children by giving them our Time and teaching them to use their Talents by using the gifts we have been given by God to serve others.
