



Stewardship...Read Me!

As we continue our journey in Ordinary
Time toward the season of Lent, we
continue to focus on how our Sunday
readings help us make God first in our
lives by embracing a stewardship way of life.



Fifth Sunday in Ordinary Time

<u>IS 6: 1-2A, 3-8; PS 138: 1-5, 7-8; 1 COR 15:1-11 or 1 COR 15:3-8, 11; LK 5: 1-11</u>

Our readings today remind us of the great privilege we have in calling ourselves children of the God. The First Reading from Isaiah describes a vision of the prophet in which angels surround the Lord. They proclaim, "Holy, holy, holy is the LORD of hosts! All the earth is filled with his glory!" Our God invites us to such deep intimacy and friendship with Him that we sometimes forget just how majestic and unspeakably holy He truly is.

While we can approach Him with the confidence of a child before his father, we must also remember the deep reverence and awe that we owe to Him. This sense of awe and reverence should motivate us to deepen the relationship of our stewardship way of life as well. As we contemplate the holiness of God, we come to a heightened awareness of what a privilege it is that He has chosen to include us in His work of spreading the Gospel to others through the grateful sharing of the gifts He has given us. We can make the words of the prophet Isaiah our own: "Then I heard the voice of the Lord saying, "Whom shall I send" Who will go for us? Here I am, I said, send me!"

In the Gospel passage from Luke, Jesus instructs Simon to lower his nets for a catch despite an unsuccessful night of fishing. Peter is skeptical but obeys and is amazed at the catch of fish that he makes. He falls on his knees before Jesus in astonishment.

This sense of awe and reverence before God should motivate us to deepen our stewardship way of life. When we truly embrace a stewardship way of life, putting our talents, time and treasure at the service of the God, our Father, we too will be astonished at what God will do.

Our lives may take a direction beyond our wildest imaginings. But just as Jesus reassured Simon, "Be not afraid," He reassures us, by saying, "Be not afraid of living a stewardship way of life". Rather, we should embrace the adventure it presents us and prepare to be astonished by what our awesome God will do. "Here I am Lord, send me!"

Something to think about:

As a Catholic Christian, have you ever thought about the words from Isaiah "Here I am Lord, send me?" What is God asking of me from my life? Am I ready to accept his call? Am I even listening? All of us have a lot of noise in our lives and competition for our attention - from our family, from work, hobbies, and other pursuits. We need to try to carve out a little time to thank God for what he has given us, the blessings and talents he has entrusted to us to use to help others. Try this – Find an extra few minutes for prayer to start the day (that's "time"). Consider volunteering to serve in a parish ministry – as a Greeter or as a Donut Minister – no experience required (that's "talent"). Then, if you are financially able, give a little extra in the Offertory or to the Annual Catholic Appeal (that's "treasure"). Any or all of these answer God's call toward leading a stewardship way of life. And to answer his question, "Whom should I send?" we reply, "Here I am Lord, send me."
