


Questions for Faith Sharing Mar. 16 Second Sunday of Lent

Stewardship & Lent Prayers & Gratitude

STEWARDSHIP, It's of about grainule. It's all about grainule. It's all about grainule. It's all about grainule.

First Sunday of Lent

DT 26: 4-10; PS 91:1-2, 10-15; ROM 10: 8-13; LK 4: 1-13

And so, we begin, the holy and, for some of us, the daunting season of Lent. This is the season in our liturgical year when the Church encourages us to increase our prayer, fasting, and almsgiving to help us enter more deeply into the mystery of our Lord's Passion and Death and to celebrate more fully His Resurrection.

The First Reading, from Deuteronomy, presents a positive way to approach Lent. The passage begins with Moses speaking to the people. He reminds them that the Lord saw their affliction and responded mercifully to their cry by delivering them from oppression in Egypt, and by bringing them to a land flowing with milk and honey. Moses teaches the people to respond as grateful stewards for all that God has done for them and all he has given them.

As grateful stewards ourselves, we can look at these 40 days as "good soil" that God is giving us as a gift so our "seeds" of faith can grow to help us become closer to Him and become more like Him. We can choose to use each of these days to make a generous response to our God, who sent His own Son to deliver us from the affliction and oppression caused by sin.

Jesus, by His own example in today's Gospel, demonstrates the necessity of setting aside a period devoted especially to prayer and fasting as a means of strengthening our spiritual muscles. Just before the launch of His public ministry, He was "led by the Holy Spirit into the desert for forty days, to be tempted by the devil." In our lives, we too may have been led into the desert by temptation and weaknesses. During Lent, pray that the Holy Spirit will lead us out of our personal desert where our temptations reside.

While our Lord was strong enough to withstand the temptations of the devil on His own, we most certainly are not! We must turn to the Holy Spirit and ask Him to show us where we need to grow and then rely on the Holy Spirit for strength and guidance throughout these 40 days of growth.

Perhaps we will be led to take on a spiritual reading program, a daily time for meditation and extra time for prayer, or weekly attendance at a daily Mass or at the Stations of the Cross. Maybe we'll be inspired to fast from our favorite food or our social media fix or take on a project that serves the poor in our community like the Upper Room. Any and all of these can help us strengthen our relationship with God.




Deacon Jim's something to think about:

As we begin Lent this week, we are called to spend time in prayer, fasting, and almsgiving. Each of these has its own path that can lead us through these next 40 days. Today let's begin with **Prayer**: In prayer we seek to hear God's voice and allow his Word to penetrate our fear and resistance so that we can hear what he wants us to know. And what he wants us to know first is that "You are my beloved son or daughter with whom I am well pleased." God loves us, no strings attached. Over time, as our prayer deepens into a constant awareness of God's goodness, the spirit ("seeds") of gratitude grow within us for the gifts God has given us and that we are to share. These actions build our relationship with God and lead us toward a stewardship way of life.




